

The DRUM study

What is it?

This approved study will look at whether drumming is helpful for brain connections in autism. It will involve two MRI scans and learning to drum for half an hour three times a week. The scans will be collected at Denmark Hill and we will try to arrange the drumming at a location that suits you. Participants will receive an honorarium and funding to cover their food and travel expenses.

Who is it for?

16-20 year olds on the autism spectrum.
