The Steering Group members attend decision making boards, including the Disability and Transition Partnership Board and the CAMHS Partnership Board.

The active Parent Forum members, including the Steering Group, are always happy to provide support to other parent/carers.

We work actively with other stakeholders to ensure families of disabled children and young people's views are heard in Sutton.

## **Parental Support**

We support families, children and young people to identify positive outcomes through person centred planning.

We provide help, support, information and advice including completing CAF forms, ICount registration, DLA and PIP. We can support you at meetings including Annual Reviews and school visits.

We act as a named contact working with different services to help you navigate the system.

We provide information to help you understand personal budgets.

Our Parental Supporters have passed the Council for Disabled Children's legal training qualifications and attend regular training courses including welfare benefits entitlements with the CAB.

Our Parental Supporters complete annual safe-guarding training and have enhanced DBS checks.
